On the High Instructions of the Head of State **H.E. Paul BIYA**, the Minister of the Economy, Planning and Regional Development **Mr. ALAMINE OUSMANE MEY**, proceeded on 18th December 2020 to the signing of a loan agreement by exchange of notes with the Moroccan Foreign Trade Bank (BMCE), to an amount of 25 billion CFA F.

This is the first instalment on a financial contribution of a global amount of 35 billion CFA F, to finance the first phase of the Project of renovation of the Cardinal Paul Emile Leger National Centre for the Rehabilitation of Persons with disabilities in Yaounde (CNRPH).

In essence, this project, which completes the Contract-Plan signed on 14 January 2016 between the State of Cameroon and the CNRPH for the 2016-2018 period and which will be realized by DISPRESSO CAMEROON, aims at modernizing the technical platform of the CNRPH in order to transform it into a Centre of Excellence and a reference in Cameroon and in the Central African sub-region, in terms of rehabilitation and socio-economic integration of people with disabilities.

On behalf of the President of the Republic, **H.E. Paul BIYA**, the Minister of the Economy, Planning and Regional Development, **Mr. Alamine OUSMANE MEY**, ceases this opportunity to express the gratitude of the Government of Cameroon to the Moroccan Foreign Trade Bank for this new contribution to the development efforts of the nation.
